## **General Business**



## On Projects -

- there was no info on future projects will need to speak with Council re toilet in Bakery Carpark project.
- John spoke about tree planting at eastern end of Neilson Park and applying for a Foundation grant to finance this. Will need to see what Council wants to plant there. Foundation Grants must be in by October.
- Coolah Drought relief Project was discussed at length .. Proposal from RAWCs that we provide a BBQ at Coolah, they will distribute payments direct to drought impacted families and pay our Club \$1500 for the BBQ they will also provide the food. Our Club is simply a conduit for distribution of Federal Funds. Agreed this should be the decision of a General Meeting Mal prepared to tow trailer down to Coolah and will speak with Sal Edwards the CDC for Coolah re who should be invited. There was concern raised about the legality of an open air function when COVID directive is open air functions allowable at max of 30!! Mal to contact RAWCs for more information prior to open discussion.
